

## **Referees Responsibilities & Duties: -**

Before Kick Off:

Speak with both Team Managers & Captains at an agreed time (preferably 30mins before KO) and exchange Team sheets

Complete performance report for Club & submit copies to Combination for monthly feedback

Poor behaviour from Spectators & Club members should be reported with names of offenders. Clubs who do not accommodate will be fined and warned of their responsibilities

Keep supporters on the opposite touchline to technical area

Managers to be instructed to stay in Technical area

## **Club Responsibilities: -**

A Club in conjunction with Referee must organise for their Team Manager & Captain to meet with Referee at an agreed time (preferably 30mins before KO) and exchange Team sheets

When & where possible Clubs must keep Supporters on the opposite touchline to technical area

Clubs to have a designated Official to uphold Club values and assist Referee when required

Each Club to provide a member or non-member to attend a Referees course or Assistant course

Provide regular assessment report of Referees performance to Combination/Ref/Man Committee. Club needs to be able to qualify their remarks & comments

Clubs will sign a code of conduct each season on behalf of Players and Officials.

## **JFA Responsibilities: -**

Persistent /repeat Offenders will be asked to attend Ref/Man Committee to explain their poor record. Should they fail to attend or conform in the future, the JFA has the right to use their discretion on deciding any future punishment.

Provide monthly disciplinary reports to Combination, Ref/Man & Referee Committee

Players Representing either the JFA or Leagues will be told of their responsibilities and must adhere to them at all times

**\*\*** Set out a points system based on number of yellow and red cards at the start of the season with a points deduction system applied for a poor disciplinary record
